Following two successful years where this team had won back to back Adrian Murray Cups we looked forward to our minor campaign. We got together as a group last October with gym and pitch work. The squad did individual training sessions over the h<mark>oli</mark>days and we were back in earnest at the start of January. We played a few challenges in the next few weeks and ventured off to Croghan Hill for a team building day in February. Dragging telephone poles up an extinct volcano and being submersed in bog water will bond a team. Meath senior hurling captain Sean Geraghty presented the squad with their Adrian Murray Cup medals in late February and we received great news that Glenveagh Homes are the new Meath hurling sponsor.

On the first weekend in April we were to play Carlow for the right to get into the Leinster group of Laois, Offaly & Dublin. A challenge match against Antrim was scheduled for Sunday 15th March in preparation for the clash. With lockdown none of this happened. Nights in the gym we replaced wi<mark>th</mark> individual training programmes. Squad members showed great resilience in this different environment, setting up home gyms, running in local fields, having ball wall sessions by the side of the house, doing bronco runs by themselves and much more unseen work. On the weekend of the 13th/14th of June the squad undertook a 100km solo challenge in aid of Jigsaw in Navan and we raised some well deserved funds for Jigsaw who work in the area of mental

health, supporting young people, giving advice & offering a listening ear. We got back collectively on September 21 & credit the squad and clubs, the lads are on top of their game. Well done to the county board for getting the schedule of games for clubs & although it has been a truncated season, we are delighted to be playing. The club championships have been very competitive and the final sees two great rivals in Trim and Ratoath face off. In addition, there are other trophies to be won in the last couple of weeks of the club season & we are sure to have some thrillers. From a county perspective, we are setting our sights on the opening game in the Peadar Lehane Cup away to Wicklow on October 24. We hope to bring home the cup last held by Meath in 2017.


